


HALTER OR HACKAMORE SIZING GUIDE

How to Measure Your Equine Partner for a Parelli Halter or Hackamore

- 1. Use a Savvy String to measure the circumference of the muzzle one inch below the cheek bone. Measure three times and compute the average.
- 2. Find your measurement on the chart below.
- 3. If the measurement is on the cusp of two sizes, consider going with the larger of the two sizes.
- 4. Use a Savvy String to measure the circumference of the throatlatch. Measure three times and compute the average.
- 5. Find your measurement on the chart.
- 6. If suggested size for the muzzle or the throatlatch is larger, choose the size that is larger.
- 7. Note: The throatlatch is adjustable downward from the high number listed on the chart, the muzzle size is not adjustable.
- 8. Examples:
 - a. Muzzle-21 inches / Throatlatch-40 inches = Regular
 - b. Muzzle-14 inches / Throatlatch-35 inches = Arabian
 - c. Muzzle-65 centimeters / Throatlatch 103 centimeters = Draft
 - d. Muzzle-44 centimeters / Throatlatch 83 centimeters = Arabian
- 9. This chart is only a suggested guide. If you find your halter does not fit, simply call our office to exchange it for the correct size.

Suggested Sizes for Halter and Hackamore Measurements				
Name of	Muzzle		Throatlatch	
Size	Inches	CM	Inches	CM
Mini	10 - 13	25.5 - 33	16 - 27	40.5 - 68.5
Pony	13 - 17	33 - 43	up to 33	up to 84
Arabian	17 - 21	43 - 53.5	up to 39	up to 99
Regular	21 - 23	53.5 - 58.5	up to 40	up to 101.5
Warmblood	23 - 25	58.5 - 63.5	up to 41	up to 104
Draft	25 - 29	63.5 - 74	up to 43	up to 109
